

#### SCHOLARSHIP FOR VISITING MEDICAL STUDENTS

Kaweah Health's (KH) Office of Graduate Medical Education is offering a scholarship to support visiting students who have shown a commitment to serve medically disadvantaged populations. KH serves the healthcare needs of approximately 500,000 people across a diverse mix of races, ethnicities, income levels, education and health status. We hope that through this opportunity we can attract and mentor students that are interested in health equity, advocacy and community service. Preference will be given to students with ties or experiences working with the underserved rural communities. The scholarship is designed to give unique opportunities for career development, to provide support, and to defray the cost of travel and fees (i.e. rotation fees, etc.).

In addition to the exciting learning opportunities our clerkships offer, the scholarship awardees will also receive:

- Waived Rotation Fee
- \$1000 for travel and housing costs (a check will be provided upon
- arrival)
- Support and guidance from resident and faculty mentors

All 4<sup>th</sup> year medical students in good standing who demonstrate commitment for:

- Community service
- Advocacy
- Social Justice
