

# **KHMC Inpatient Pharmacy Services**

The Inpatient Pharmacy Department serves three campuses with 24/7 operations and a team of over 120 individuals, including more than 50 clinical pharmacists. We practice within an integrated, **decentralized model** that places pharmacists directly on patient care units, where pharmacists are active members of the healthcare team.

Pharmacy specialty areas include infectious diseases, critical care, emergency medicine, oncology, pediatrics, anemia management, formulary management, and pain management, offering opportunities for pharmacists to expand expertise across diverse clinical areas.

As a UCSF Center of Excellence in Experiential Education, KHMC Pharmacy hosts a variety of pharmacy student rotations annually. Our pharmacists serve as preceptors, participate in hospital committees, round with medical teams, and are valued as essential contributors to patient outcomes and hospital initiatives.

## KHMC PGY1 Pharmacy Residency Program Overview

Kaweah Health Medical Center offers an **ASHP-accredited PGY1 program for two residents.** The pharmacy practice residency is a 52-week postgraduate curriculum that offers training opportunities in a variety of acute care and practice leadership settings.

KHMC is a **community-based teaching hospital** committed to developing the next generation of clinical pharmacy leaders. Our PGY1 residency cultivates skills in leadership, evidence-based practice, and community service while providing comprehensive training in both clinical and management areas.

Residents gain diverse, hands-on experience across patient care settings, building the confidence and expertise needed for advanced practice. Graduates are well-prepared to excel as acute care clinical pharmacists or to pursue PGY2 residencies and fellowships for further specialization.
