
## **TOPIC 2: Using Cath Lab Report**

Medications given during a Cath Lab or Interventional Radiology (IR )procedure are not documented in PowerChart. They are documented in a different system (Sensis) that provides needed functionality specific to Cath Lab/IR.

This is a patient safety issue related to medication administration.

## What the nurse needs to know:

- ⇒ The procedure record with a list of medications given is available immediately after the procedure documentation is completed.
- The receiving nurse must verify what medications were given and when
- To find medication administration information
  - 1. Find procedure documentation in Results Review
  - 2. Click on the Imaging Tab
  - 3. Find Cardiac Cath Procedure on the Imaging Tab, Double click




- 4. The Cath Lab Procedure Nurse Note will open.
- 5. There will be a link to the PDF.
- 6. Click on the link to open the report

NOTE: Doctors procedure report looks different and does not have the link!!

Medications and IV Fluids are recorded here. Cath Lab/IR will complete a paper SBAR form that will accompany the patient's chart and is given to the receiving nurse. This paper report also has the medication administration information.

USE these two tools to verify medication administration and avoid medication errors!!
