Must continue to meet institutional requirements

Must have support of clinical leadership and GMEC

Must apply every 30 days

>90 days - invoke extraordinary circumstances & transfer residents away

Must still prioritize: **work hour requirements; adequate resources and training; adequate supervision**

ACGME Statements

- No furloughs for residents
- No working without adequate PPE
- New policy to allow public sanction to identify alleged egregious events
- No graduating from med school early
- All CLER & ACGME site visits currently suspended
(Anesthesiology was scheduled for September 1)



Frequent Questions from Trainees

Will I see the patients I need to see to graduate?

Case Logs of graduates of a program who were on duty during the pandemic (particularly those in their ultimate or penultimate years) will be judiciously considered in light of the impact of the pandemic on that program. The program can delineate for the Review Committee how it was affected by the pandemic in the Major Changes section of ADS during the next Annual Update

Will I be board eligible if I am quarantined?

A 2 week quarantine will not be counted as time away from the program per ABMS

Can I graduate if I was pulled from a rotation due to COVID?

This is up to the program director, with input from the CCC.

Do Telehealth visits count?

During COVID yes, but afterwards, each RC will need to decide


